Terms and Conditions



(1) Provided Service

Fujitsu AI Computing Broker (ACB) is a run-time aware middleware that optimizes GPU allocation and manages memory oversubscription. By leveraging runtime-aware scheduling, full memory access, and advanced orchestration, ACB minimizes idle time, boosts throughput, and improves efficiency.

The ACB monitors functions calls to the AI framework and track GPU usage for dynamic resource assignment.

The User executes the ACB provided by Fujitsu based on the User's request and submits Results to Fujitsu as part of the mandatory data sharing described below. Fujitsu is willing to explore options for using anonymized results, co-authoring a white paper, etc., and encourage the User to reach out for additional information.

(2) Grant of License

Fujitsu hereby grants the Applicant a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable, royalty-free license to use the ACB solely for **non-commercial purposes** for a period of **thirty (30) consecutive days** commencing on the date of first access or use ("Trial Period").

(3) Mandatory Data Sharing

As a condition of this license, the Applicant agrees to **share metrics, results and/or other appropriate feedback** obtained through the use of ACB during the Trial Period with Fujitsu. Such information may be completed by responding to a survey no later than seven (7) days after the end of the Trial Period.

(4) Restrictions

1. This Service is only available to the Users residing in countries as defined in Article 2 (Prerequisites), Section 1 of Terms of Use (<https://en-portal.research.global.fujitsu.com/content/terms-of-use-2024060701.pdf>) and who possess a verifiable institutional email address, as approved by Fujitsu.
2. The User may use the Service and Results only for its own research purposes, and may not use them for any commercial purposes.
3. The User shall not use the ACB for any commercial purpose, including but not limited to offering services to third parties or generating revenue.
4. The User shall not modify, distribute, or reverse-engineer the ACB.
5. The User shall not use the ACB beyond the Trial Period without entering into a separate written agreement with Fujitsu.
6. The User shall notify Fujitsu in advance of any mention of the Service and/or Results in publications such as papers and shall follow Fujitsu's instructions regarding citations and other related matters.
